COAST CHARTER DISTANCE LEARNING AGREEMENT

- _____ • The distance learning program is provided through COAST Charter School. The grade level teachers are providing all work associated with distance learning.
- _____ • Students may work on classwork beyond school hours.
- _____ • Students may transition back to school if needed but may not transition back to distance learning without authorization. Students are asked to commit to completing a minimum of one 9-weeks session before transitioning back to the school.
- _____ • Students who are transitioning back to school must give notice to COAST two weeks prior to returning.
- _____ • If devices are requested, they are to be returned to the school in the same condition or with reasonable amounts of wear and tear. Damages are at the expense of the guardian.
- _____ • If devices are requested, they are expected only to be used for schoolwork, and the use is subject to school rules.
- _____ • Students may not log on to another student's programs. Students may not assist other students without permission.
- _____ • Students may NOT extend work beyond the end of the specified end of the 9-weeks date. The online school's semester may extend beyond the end of the semester, but the student must follow semester dates for completion to receive a passing grade.
- _____ • Students who do not work on their courses and give the false impression of doing so may fall behind and receive an F for the course.
- _____ • Repeated issues may result in the student being denied permission to take other online classes in the future. This includes not staying current with the online work and the plagiarism of work.
- _____ • Students may not drop a course once in progress. Even if the grades are poor, the student may not WF (withdrew failing) or WP (withdrew passing) the course. A WF or WP will result in an F grade in the academic records. Rare exceptions may be considered by the principal only in extraordinary circumstances. Falling behind in work is not a reason for an exception. Parents are encouraged and expected to monitor their student's progress in the online course.
- _____ • For Middle School Students; If the work for the class is finished before the end of the semester, the student will present evidence of this to the teacher with a copy of the final grade for the course. Once this completion has been verified by the teacher, the student may then be allowed to complete work for other courses.
- _____ • Students are expected to complete all assignments in a timely and appropriate manner. Students who fall behind must take part in a mandatory conference to review academic performance or continuation in the distance learning academy.
- _____ • Students who violate these terms will lose the opportunity to take other online classes in the future.
